  - General Educational Development (GED) certificate, or
  - An academic transcript showing successful completion of at least a two-year program fully acceptable toward a bachelor's degree, or
  - If you did not complete high school, documentation from a school official that you excelled in high school and plan to enroll in at least an associate degree program.
- For home schooled students, a transcript signed by a parent or guardian documenting the successful completion of secondary education, listing the courses you completed, or a state-issued home school certification credential.
