Concurrent high school students must be eligible to satisfy the high school curricular requirements for college admission no later than the spring semester of their senior year. A high school student admitted under the provisions set forth below may enroll in a combined number of high school and college courses per semester not to exceed a full-time college work load of 19 semester credit hours. A high school student may enroll in a maximum of 9 semester credit hours during a summer session. A high school student must meet the following requirements for admission:

Seniors:	Minimum 19 ACT composite OR 3.0 GPA and a 19 ACT in the area of enrollment	Minimum 19 ACT composite AND 17 years of age or older and a 19 ACT in the area of enrollment
Juniors:	Minimum 21 ACT composite OR 3.5 GPA and a 19 ACT in the area of enrollment	Minimum 21 ACT composite AND 16 years of age or older and a 19 ACT in the area of enrollment

To continue enrollment in following semesters, high school students concurrently enrolled in college courses must maintain a college cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.

In conjunction with the Oklahoma State Regents for High Education, Northeast Oklahoma A&M College continues to participate in the program for concurrent enrollment. NEO will provide tuition waivers to all high school students for the summer, fall and spring semesters. Under this program, high school students are eligible to receive a resident tuition waiver for up to six (6) credit hours per semester. Any remaining tuition, fees and book cost must be paid by the student. To retain, this tuition waiver, recipients must maintain a grade point average of 2.00.
