



Placement Retesting

Students who are not satisfied with test scores and class placement have the option to retest. Students may test a total of three times in each subject. There is a mandatory two-week waiting period when retesting for the first time. A \$5 retest fee per subject will be charged for each additional test. The student's highest test scores from any CPT and/or ACT tests will always be used to determine class placement in each subject.

Preparing to Retest

During the two-week waiting period, students may use free online exam prep resources to help improve test scores. The accuplacer.collegeboard.org website is the primary recommended website with official ACCUPLACER resources that are free. Other websites with additional information are also provided below.

- accuplacer.collegeboard.org—website provides access to official ACCUPLACER study resources including a free web-based app with guided learning, a PDF of sample test questions and other helpful resources
- mometrix.com/academy/accuplacer-test—website with some additional ACCUPLACER study resources that are free including reviews and practice questions for each subject
- practiceaccuplacertests.com—website that provides free advice on the format of the exam, as well as study tips and practice test materials

How to Retest at NEO

Students may retest at NEO after the two-week waiting period. Students must pay the \$5 fee for each retested subject in the Business Office prior to testing, which is located on the first floor of the Library Administration Building. Students must bring the following to the NEO testing center:

- A copy of the receipt from the Business Office and
- An official form of photo ID (i.e. student ID card or driver's license).

Where to Retest at NEO

NEO's testing center is located in the Center for Academic Success & Advisement (CASA), which is located in the basement of the Library Administration Building (next to the Post Office). After testing, students with improved test scores may be able to meet with an advisor to modify their class schedule. Students are not required to make an appointment to test or to meet with an advisor, but it is recommended to ensure availability. Office hours are Monday-Friday from 8 am-4:30 pm. It is recommended that a student begin testing no later than 3:00 pm.
