NEO DPS/Campus Police is staffed by certified police officers 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. We can be reached by calling 918-533-1243, or in case of emergency by dialing 911.



PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

NEO A&M College parking lots are color-coded to indicate the proper parking spaces for students, visitors and faculty.

- Yellow marked spots are for Student parking
- White marked spots are for Faculty parking
- Visitor spots are clearly identified with the word "VISITOR"
- Handicap spots are conveniently located and clearly marked in all parking lots
- Students May also park in the Dept. of Public Safety / Campus Police lot even though it is marked in white

If you receive a parking citation and feel you have grounds for appeal you have 5 working days from the date of issue to contest the ticket. Refer to the back of the citation for appeal procedure instructions.

Parking decals are to be placed on the lower left hand corner on the outside of the back window or on the front fork, left side of your motorcycle.

PREVENT VEHICLE CRIMES

When parking please make every effort to park in a well lighted area. Always remove valuables from plain view (i.e. bed of a pick up truck) and lock your vehicle.

FIRE DRILLS

The NEO Department of Public Safety / Campus Police conducts two fire drills each semester. The drills are done in each dorm and in the suites.

Listed below are the staging areas for students after evacuating dorms and suites:

- Russell Hall: the south side of the Fine Arts building
- Vann Hall: the south side of the Library-Administration building
- Dobson / Harrill: the mall area between Russell and Vann Halls
- Dyer Hall: The North side of the Fine Arts Building
- Quads Housing: East field at the Quads Housing
- Suites Housing: Outdoor basketball court

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

The NEO Department of Public Safety/Campus Police will notify dormitory resident directors when a Thunderstorm or Tornado Watch is issued by the National Weather Service.

We recommend students become familiar with the location of dormitory storm shelters in the event a tornado warning is issued in Ottawa Co. Most shelters are located in the basement of the NEO dorms, with the exception of the suites. Housing Complex residents should seek shelter in the basement of Dobson / Harrill Hall.

REFUGE AREA INFORMATION

Each building has a location designated as a refuge area. This is the area that you will need to go in the event of a tornado warning. Each building and dorm has signs posted which indicate the location and how to access the refuge area. Whether you are faculty, staff students or visitors please take time to become familiar with the refuge areas in the building you frequent.

SECURITY ESCORT

If for any reason you are afraid or feel unsafe walking alone on campus the NEO Department of Public Safety / Campus Police will be happy to escort you. Simply call the on-duty officer at 918-533-1243.
