Float entries are defined as a decorated exhibit or scene mounted on a mobile platform and pulled in a parade

The Decorated Vehicle category has been designed as an alternative for entering a float. Clubs are invited to decorate a vehicle of their choosing. Clubs are encouraged to walk with the vehicle, throw candy, etc. **Each vehicle, float, or group must be clearly identified with a full size poster board, with their club/group name.**

**Lineup is on E. Central after K SE to the bridge, you are able to line up one hour before start time, but you must be lined up and ready to go 15 minutes before start time. Lineup is a first come basis, there are no numbers. Please consider taking pictures of your float in process.**

Parade will begin promptly at 4:00 p.m. and will follow a route beginning at I NE and Central, to 4<sup>th</sup> Ave NE to the stadium.
