

**Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA)
Quarterly Reporting**

On February 17, 2021 NEO A & M College was notified by the U.S. Department of Education of additional funding for emergency grants to students under the CRRSAA passed by the U. S. Congress and signed by the President on December 27, 2020.

Method used to determine eligibility for emergency grants	NEO identified students by comparing a list of all students enrolled in the spring 2021 semester with the eligibility requirements under the CRRSAA provisions. All enrolled students <i>except</i> international and undocumented students were eligible for emergency grants.
Instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution concerning the emergency grants	All students enrolled in the spring 2021 semester were notified via email of the availability of the emergency grants. Students were notified that they could receive a check for the full amount of their emergency grant or have it applied to their outstanding charges at NEO. Students could submit their preference through an online form or by answering a web question on the student portal.
NEO Allocation formula for emergency grants	Award amounts were based on students' Pell eligibility and hours enrolled. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pell eligible students received \$65.00 per credit hour • Non Pell eligible students received \$50.00 per credit hour • Concurrently enrolled high school students received \$45.00 per credit hour
